

ORDINANCE NO. 4.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO, LICENCING CARD ROOMS AND CARD TABLES: BEER PARLORS OR PLACES WHERE WHERE IS SOLD: AND DOGS: PROVIDING A FEE THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE: PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS HEREOF, AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION.

Be IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO.;

Section 1. That any person, firm or corporation conducting any card room or running any card tables; conducting any beer parlor or selling any beer, shall first pay to said Village the fee therefor as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to conduct or permit the playing of any game of cards or any game in which playing cards are used in any place of business, place of amusement, or in any place/room or place open to the public within said Village without first obtaining from said Village a licence therefor, signed by the Chairman of the Village Trustees; and before the issuance of said licence there shall be paid to the Village Treasurer the sum of One Dollar per month for each card table operated within said Village.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or run any beer parlor, or sell in any place of business place of amusement, or in any room or space open to the public without first obtaining a license therefor; and before the issuance of said license the persons desiring to sell beer within said Village shall pay to the Village Treasurer the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per year for said license.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to own, keep or harbor within the Village of Castleford any dog without first paying a license therefor as follows;

For a male dog or a female spayed dog over the age of six months, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year,

For a female dog the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per year, payable on the first day of every year.

Section 5. Upon the payment of said licence fee, the Village Shall furnish a license tag for such dog which shall be attached to the collar of said dog at all times; and all dogs not licensed or not bearing a license tag are hereby declared to be a nuisance, and shall be taken up and impounded,; and every dog so seized shall be kept in the pound for forty-eight (48) hours. At any time during said period, the owner or keeper of said dog may redeem the same by procuring a license, if one has not already been obtained, and by providing a collar and tag and paying an additional sum of One Dollar (1.00).

Section 6. All dogs impounded and not redeemed within forty-eight hours from the time the same are impounded may be sold or shall be condemned and killed.

Section 7. Any person, firm or corporation conducting any card table or running any card game, or operating any card room without first having obtained a license therefor shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section 8. Any person, firm or corporation conducting any beer parlor or selling any beer in a public place within the Village of Castleford without first obtained a license therefor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)

Section 9. Any person who shall own, keep or harbor within said Village any dog, as herein provided, without first having obtained a license therefor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect from and after

its passage, approval and publication.
