## ORDINANCE NO. 4.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OFCASTLEFORD, IDAHO,
LICENCING CARD ROOMS AND CARD TABLES: BEER PARLORS OR PLACES WHER
WHERE IS SOLD: AND DOGS:PROVIDINGA FEE THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING
FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE:PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE
VIOLATIONS HEREOF, AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE
EFFEC T FROM AND AFTER PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION.

Be IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO.;

SEction 1. hat any person, firm or corporation conducting any card roomor running any card tables; conducting any beer parlor orselling any beer, shall first pay to said village the fee therefor as hereafherfter set forth.

Scetion 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to conduct or permit the playing of any game of cardsor any game in which playing cards are used in any place of business, place of amusement, or in any place/room or placeopen to the public within said Villagewithout first abtaining forom said Village a licence therefor, signed by the Chairman of the Village rustees; and before the issuance of said licence there shall be paid to the Village Treasurer the sum of One Dollar per month for each card table operated within said Village.

Section3, It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or run any beer parlor, or sell in any place of business place of amusement, or in any room or space open to the public without first obtaining a license therefor; and before the issuance of said license the persons desiring to sell beer within said Village shall pay to the Village Treasurer the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per year for said license.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to own, keep or harbor within the Village of Castleford any dog without first paying a licensetherefor as follows;

For a male dog or a female spayed dog over the age of six months, the sum of One Dollar(\$1.00) per year,

For a female dog the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per year, p payable on the first day of every year.

Section 5. Upon the payment of said licence fee, the Village Shall furnish alicense tag for such dog which shall be attached to the collar of said dog at all times; and all dogs not licensed or not bearing a license tag are hereby declared to be a nuisance, and shall be taken up and impounded,; and every dog so seized shall be kept in the pound for forty-eight (48) hours. At any timeduring said period, the owner or keeper of said dog may redeem the same by procuring a license, if one hasnot already been obtained, and by providing a collar and tagand paying an additional sum of One Dollar(1.00).

Section 6. All dogs impounded and not redeemed within forty- eight ho hours from the time the same are impounded may be sold or shall be condemmed and killed.

Section 7. Any person, firm or corporation conducting any card table or running any card game, or operating any card room without first having obtained a license therefor shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section 8. Any person, firm or corporation conducting any beer parlor or sekling any beer in a public place within the Village of Castleford without first obtained a license therefor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)

Section 9. Any nerson who shall own, keep or harbor within said Village any dog, as herein provided, without first having obtained a license therefor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor s shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect from and after
