

An Ordinance of the Village of Castleford, Idaho, making it unlawful for any person, firm, or Corporation to have in its possession any fire works, fire crackers, roman candle, skyrocket or like article containing powder or explosive chemicals or to fire, set off, or discharge any such article within the Village Defining a misdemeanor, and providing a penalty for the violation There of, and providing when this Ordinance shall take effect.

Be it ordained by the Chairmann and board of trustees of the Village of Castleford, Idaho.

Section 1

That it shall be unlawful after the taking effect of this Ordinance for any person, firm, or corporation to have in his, her, its or their possession any fireworks, firecracker, Roman Candle, skyrocket, or like article containing powder or explosives, chemicals, or to display or offer for sale any such article or thing containing powder or explosive chemicals within the village of Castleford, Idaho, or to set off, fire or discharge any such article containing powder or explosive chemicals within said village.

Section 2

That any violation of this ordinance is hereby defined to be a misdemeanor.

Section 3

That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be judged to be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be fined any sum not exceeding \$100.00 that every violation there shall be a separate Offence.

Section 4

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication

Ordinance # 25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO, LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 1948, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF APRIL, 1949 UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID VILLAGE, TO PROVIDE REVENUE TO PAY THE GENERAL CURRENT EXPENCES OF SAID VILLAGE DURING SAID FISCAL YEAR: MAKING A SPECIAL LEVY OF 15 MILLS UPON EVERY ONE DOLLAR OF THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF SAID VILLAGE; PROVIDING THAT THE VILLAGE CLERK SHALL FILE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF TWIN FALLS CO. IDAHO IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION: AND PROVIDING THE TIME THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO.

Section 1

There is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Castleford, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of May, 1948 and ending at the close of business on the last day of April 1949, ad valorem taxes as follows:

Ten (10) mills upon every dollar (1.00) of the assessed value of all taxable property within said village, to defray the general expences of said village for the fiscal year.

Section #2

Fifteen (15) mills upon every One Dollar (1.00) of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within said village to defray the costs and expences of lighting the streets of said village.

Section 3

The Village Clerk of said Village is hereby ordered and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Co. Auditor of Twin Falls Co, Idaho, Immediately upon its passage and approval and publication

Section #4

This ordinance shall be in full force & effect from and after its passage, approval & Publication
