**Backflow update**: Report given to council with no new concerns or action required.

### **New Business**

**Demolition/Control Burn at 400 Main Street**: After presentation by Chuck Day, Castleford School Principal and discussion by council and citizens Jennifer motions to allow demolition and control burn at 400 Main Street, Che 2nds, motion passed.

**Presentation for educational classroom at 400 Main Street**: After presentation by Chuck Day, Castleford Principal discussion by council Jennifer motions to allow the school district to place a building approximately 16x48 at 400 Main Street for Career Technical Education as long as the school is compliant with Castleford City Planning and Zoning Ordinances and meet requirement of the Twin Falls County building permits. Stacie is to issue letter on behalf of approval with approval expiring 1 year from date. Che 2nds, motion is passed.

**Smiles Grant**: Chuck Day requests city council consider applying for the SMILES Grant on behalf of the School with funds, if awarded going to the school Football Lights project. Che motions that Stacie research the grant and bring this request back to the November Agenda for decision, Jennifer 2nds, motion passed.
