

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO, LEVYING ADVALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE 1ST DAY OF MAY, 1956 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF APRIL 1957, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID VILLAGE, TO PROVIDE REVENUE TO PAY THE GENERAL CURRENT EXPENDITURES OF SAID VILLAGE DURING SAID FISCAL YEAR: MAKING A LEVY OF 20.0 MILLS UPON EVERY ONE DOLLAR OF ASSESSED VALUATION OF SAID VILLAGE FOR GENERAL REVENUE AND MUNICIPAL PURPOSES OF SAID VILLAGE: PROVIDING THAT THE VILLAGE CLERK SHALL FILE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHO, IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION, AND PROVIDING THE TIME THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO:

SECTION I: There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Castleford, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of May, 1956 and ending at the close of business on the 1st day of April, 1957, advalorem taxes as follows:

Twenty mills (20) upon every one Dollar of assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Village of Castleford, Idaho, for general revenue and municipal purposes to defray general expenses of said village for said fiscal year.

SECTION II: The Village Clerk of said Village is hereby ordered to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Auditor of Twin Falls County, Idaho, immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.

SECTION III: The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
