

ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A UNIFORM CHARGE OR FEE TO BE REQUIRED MONTHLY FROM EACH OWNER, TENANT, OR OTHER OCCUPANT OF PREMISES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO, FOR SERVICES RECEIVED BY SAID PROPERTY BY ANY OF THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS: PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SUCH UNIFORM RATE, CHARGE, OR PENALTIES AND THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF IN CASE OF FAILURE TO PAY THE RATES AND CHARGES FOR SAID WATER SERVICE: RESERVING THE RIGHT UNTO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SAID VILLAGE TO CHANGE OR REVISE RATES: PROVIDING FOR THE REPAIR OF METERS: PROVIDING A SAVING CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the Village of castleford, idaho, deem it advisable that said Village shall construct, acquire and install, and thereafter own, maintain and operate a water system in, at and for said Village which shall be payable out of the earnings and revenues of the system and the Board of Trustees has the right, and authority duty to provide for the revenues of said system by fixing the rates and charges and requiring payment thereof for the furnishing of services to those and the property served by said system and its facilities in order to pay the cost and expence of the maintenance and operation of said system, principal and interest of the bond issue authorized by ordinance No. 32 and ordinance No. 33 of said Village, and to pay all the charges and expence incidental thereto, as permitted by statute and Ordinance Nos. 32 and 33;

NOW THEREFORE Be it ordained by the chairman and board of Trustees of the Village of Castleford Of Castleford

Section 1. The following minimum rates and charges are hereby fixed for water service and shall be paid therefor.

Character of User	Minimum Monthly Rate
Residences	\$ 4.00 for 6000 gals.
Business Establishments	\$ 4.50 for 7000 gals.
Churches	\$ 3.50 for 6000 Gals.
Schools	\$ 20.00 For 30,000 Gals.
Residences	8c. per 1000 gallons or fraction thereof over 6000 Gallons.
Churches	8c per 1000 gallons or fraction thereof over 6000 Gallons
Schools	8c. per 1000gallons or fraction thereof over 30,000 gallons .

All of the foregoing rates and charges for water service and any and all charges which will be fixed hereby by the board of Trustees for such service shall be paid on or before the 5th day of the month of June 1952 and on the 5th day of each and every month thereafter, and if not so paid shall become delinquent on said date & shall bear interest at the rate of eight per cent (8%) per annum from the date of delinquency until paid.

Section 2 The Board of Trustees hereby expressly reserves the right to change or revise the rates hereinbefore provided for by action of the Board duly entered in entered in its minutes

Section 3 The Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and directed at the end of five (5) days after the date of the first delinquency of any such charges, to cut off the water services from the premises to which such services shall remain cut off until all such charges, plus penalties and interest shall be paid. and said services

Section # 4. In all cases where meters are lost, injured, or broken by carelessness, or negligence of owners or occupants of premises, they shall be replaced, repaired by or under the direction of the Board of Trustees and the cost charged against the owner or occupant, and in case of nonpayment the water shall be shut off and will not be turned on until such charge for turning on the water are paid; that in the event of the meters getting out of order by failing to register properly, the consumer shall be charged on an estimate made by the board of Trustees on the average monthly consumption during the last three months that the same was in good order.

Section #5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section # 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the BUHL HERALD, a news paper of general circulation within the the Village of Castleford, Idaho, and being printed and published in the city of Buhl, Idaho and being the official newspaper of the Village of Castleford, Idaho.
