

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO, LEVYING ADVALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF MAY 1953, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF APRIL, 1954, UPON ALL GENERAL CURRANT EXPENDITURES OF SAID VILLAGE DURING SAID FISCAL YEAR: MAKING A LEVY 20.0 mills upon the every one dollar of the assessed valuation of said village for general revenue and municipal purposes of said village; providing that the village clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance with the county auditor of twin falls county, idaho, immediately after its passage, approval and publication, and providing for the time this ordinance shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAORMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD.

SECTION I. There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Castleford, idaho, for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of May, 1953 and ending at the close of business on the last day of April 1, 1954, advalorem taxes as follows.

Twenty Mills (20.0) upon every one Dollar (\$1.00 of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Village of Castleford, Idaho, FOR GENERAL revenue and Municipal purposes to defray general expences of said village for said fiscal year.

SECTION II. The Village Clerk of said Village is hereby ordered to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Auditor of Twin Falls County, Idaho, immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.

Section III. this ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage, approval and publication.

WHEREAS, said petition is signed by a number of qualified electors residing within the corporate limits in and for said Village, in a number at least a majority of the votes cast at the last general Village election, and,

WHEREAS, the granting of said petition is for the best interest of said Village and will not materially mar the symmetry thereof,

Now, Therefore, be it resolved, by the chairman and board of Trustees of the Village of Castleford Idaho:
