ORDINANCE # 39

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR A DEPOSIT BY ALL USERS PRIOR TO CONNECTION AND USE OF WATER FROM VILLAGE WATER SYSTEM : PROVIDING FOR RESTRICTION AGAINST ANY PERSON, EXCEPT AUTHORIZED VILLAGE EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS, FROM DISTURBING, OR DIVERTING OR TAKING ANY WATER MANIPULATING OPERATING REPAIRING CONNECTING OR DISCONNECTING: THEREFROM AND AUTHORIZING VILLAGE EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS ALONE TO OPERATE, REPAIR, CONNECT AND DISCONNECT, DIVERT WATER FOR AND FROM SAID WATER SYSTEM: PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND FOR PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS the Village of Castleford, Idaho, has heretofore, by authority of Ordinance Nos. 32, 33, 34, of said Village, as authorized under the laws of the State of Idaho, constructed, acquired, installed and shall and does own, maintain and operate a water system in and for said Village, and is authorized thereunder to fix charges for maintenance and operation of said water system and works and,

Whereas , it appears necessary for the proper operation of said water system that regulations be passed providing for a deposit to be made with the Clerk of the Village for the purpose of insuring payment of water charges, by all users of said system, prior to using or connection with said water system, and ,

Whereas, it further appears necessary for the proper protection and operation of said water system to regulate the use of said water, the turning on or off of all outlets from said system to users thereof and the disturbing, manipulation, operation, repair, connecting and disconnectng tur off or on of outlets therefrom,

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED the chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Castleford, Idaho.

Section I. That every person, residence, business establishment, church and school who desires to become users to and from the Village of Castleford, Idaho, water system shall pay the sum of \$5.00 to the Clerk of the Village of Castleford, Idaho, said sum to be held as a deposit to be paid prior to becoming a user of said water system and said sum to be returned to said person residence, business establishment, shurchand school after said user ceses to be a user therefrom, and upon full payment of all rates and charges due for the use of said water to the said Village.

Section II. That the Board of Trustees of the Vilage of Castleford, Idaho, be directed and aurthorized by subsequent minute entry to employ a person or persons who shall turn on and off all outlets to said water system and manipulate, operate , repair, connect and disconnect said water system or outlets therefrom and ho other person shall in any manner turn on or off any outlet to said system or manipulate, operate, repair, connect or disconnect damage or take any water without lawful aurthority for said system or from said system.

Section III. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$100.00 and costs or upon failure to pay s such fine and costs, shall be committed to the custody of the Village Marshall and be confined in the Village Jail at the rate of \$1.50 per day untill such fine and costs are paid in full.

Section IV. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage. approval and publication, an an emergency exists therefor.
