

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PUNCH BOARDS, CHANCE SPINDLES, OR CHANCE GAMES; PROVIDING FOR APPLICATION FOR ISSUING OF LICENSES OR STAMPS; FIXING LICENSES OR STAMP FEES; PROVIDING THE AGES OF PERSONS PERMITTED TO PLAY OR OPERATE THE SAME; DEFINING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; DEFINING MISDEMEANOR; PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BEIT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, COUNTY OF TWIN FALLS, STATE OF IDAHO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful and punishable as a misdemeanor for any person, firm, corporation or association to possess, sell, operate or give away chance or chances, operate or to keep for the purpose of operating any punch board, chance spindle or chance game within the limits of the Village of Castleford, Idaho without first having obtained a license or stamp from said Village to operate such punch boards, chance spindle or spindles, or chance prize games as provided for by this ordinance.

Section 2. Any person, firm, corporation or association desiring to possess, own, operate, sell or give away any chance upon any punch board, chance spindle or chance prize game shall make application to the Village Clerk of said Village for a license or stamp to possess, own, operate, sell or give away chance prize game and pay the fees therefor as provided in this ordinance.

Section 3. Such application shall be made upon a blank provided by said Village Clerk and shall contain the following information, to-wit: The name of the applicant; the name and location of the place where it is proposed to operate said punch board, chance spindle or chance prize game; the kind of device and make, number of chances, payment of chance--cash or merchandise--.

Such application shall be signed and verified by the applicant or if the application is made by a partnership then by one of the partners, or if by a corporation, then by an officer of such corporation or association.

The Village Clerk shall not issue such license or stamp until the same is approved by and ordered by the said Board of Trustees, which the Village Clerk shall, when ordered and approved by the Board of Trustees of said Village, issue such license or stamp as provided for by said Board upon payment of the fees therefor to said Village Clerk for the use of said Village.

Section 4. The fees to be collected by said Clerk shall be the sum of \$2.50 for each cash punch board, chance spindle or chance prize game; the sum of \$1.50 for each merchandise punch board, chance spindle or chance prize game.

Section 5. That before any person, firm, corporation or association shall operate any punch board, chance spindle or chance prize game there shall be attached there to and cancelled the stamp or license issued by the State of Idaho as provided by law.

Section 6. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or association to allow or permit any person under the age of 20 years to play or operate any punch board, chance spindle or chance prize game within the said Village of Castleford, Idaho.

Section 7. Any person violating any part of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
