

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, TWIN FALLS COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO, DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF REGULATING THE BUILDING, CONSTRUCTION REPAIR, OR IMPROVEMENT OF BUILDINGS IN SAID VILLAGE: PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION AND ISSUING OF BUILDING PERMITS AND PROVIDING A FEE, THEREFOR: DEFINING A MISDEMEANOR: PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO:

SECTION 1.

It is hereby declared, that it is necessary for the protection of property and life, and for the general welfare of the inhabitants thereof, that the Village of Castleford, Idaho, regulate the building, re-building, repair, removal of buildings in or into said village.

SECTION No-2.

The Village Clerk, when authorized, by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of said Village, issue a permit to any person making application and payment of the fee thereof, in the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, to build, rebuild, repair, move or remove any building, in or into said village.

SECTION 3.

Any person desiring to build, rebuild, repair, move, or remove, any building, in or into said village, shall first make an application to the Village Clerk for a permit thereof, and shall state in said application, the kind of work to be done and the general plan of the proposed construction to be built, re-built, repaired, moved, or removed in or into said village.

SECTION 4

That it shall be unlawful, and that no permit shall be issued to any person to build, re-build, repair, move, or remove, any building, in or into said village, without first providing for the construction of a chimney or flue of brick, concrete, tile, or other fireproof material, with all joints properly sealed to prevent the escape of sparks, smoke or gases; and to be constructed in accordance with general underwriters and insurance requirements, excepting buildings not to be used for human occupancy.

SECTION 5

All electric wiring, for light or power, done in said village from and after the passage and approval of this ordinance, shall be done in accordance with proper building and electrical standards, and in accordance with the requirements of the underwriters and insurance requirements.

SECTION 6

Any person, who shall build, re-build, repair, move or remove any building, in or into said village, without first securing a permit therefor; or building, re-building, repairing, moving, or removing any building contrary to the provisions of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, thereof, shall be fined a sum, not exceeding \$100, 00.

SECTION 7

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage, approval and publication of said ordinance.
