

Ordinance No. 19.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHO. ESTABLISHING A CURFEW: PROVIDING THE TIMES BETWEEN WHICH CHILDREN UNDER EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED UPON THE STREETS OR PUBLIC PLACES OF SAID VILLAGE: MAKING IT THE DUTY OF THE PARENTS, GUARDIANS, OR PERSONS HAVING CONTROL OF CHILDREN UNDER EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE TO KEEP THEM OFF THE STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES IN SAID VILLAGE BETWEEN SAID HOURS: PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARDMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, TWIN FALLS COUNTY IDAHO.

Section 1. A curfew is established in the village of castleford, Idaho, between the hours of nine o'clock P.M. and seven o'clock A.M. within which children under the age of eighteen (18) years shall not be allowed or permitted to be upon the streets or on or in public in said village, unless accompanied by and under the control of the parents, guardians, or persons having control of said children.

Section 2. That it is hereby declared to be the duty of all parents, guardians, or persons, having control of all children under the age of eighteen (18) years, to keep said children off of the streets and alleys, and out of all public places in said Village, between the hours of Nine o'clock P.M. and Seven o'clock A.M. of every day or days and that the parents, guardians, or persons having control of children, shall not allow, suffer, or permit any child under the age of eighteen (18) years to be in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or any public places of said Village between the hours of Nine o'clock P.M. and Seven o'clock A.M. of any day or days.

Section 3. The Village Marshall of said Village shall at Nine o'clock P.M. of each and every day give one short blast of the siren notifying all persons that the time of curfew has arrived; and that all children shall be at and remain at home.

Section 4. Any parent, guardian, or persons having control of any child or children who shall allow, suffer, or permit any child under the age of eighteen (18) years to be in or upon the streets, alleys or public places, of said Village between the hours of Nine o'clock P.M. and Seven o'clock A.M. of any day or days, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and no more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and shall be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
