

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 1942, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF APRIL, 1943, UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO TO PROVIDE REVENUE TO PAY THE GENERAL CURRENT EXPENDITURES OF SAID VILLAGE DURING SAID FISCAL YEAR; AND PROVIDING THAT THE VILLAGE CLERK SHALL FILE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHO IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS PASSAGE APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING THE TIME THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO:

Section 1. There is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Castleford, Idaho for the Fiscal year beginning the first day of May, 1942, and ending at the close of business on the last day of April, 1943, ad valorem taxes as follows;

Ten mills upon every One Dollar (\$1.00) of the assessed value of all taxable property within the said Village, to defray the general expenses of said Village for the said fiscal year.

Section 2. The Village Clerk of said Village is hereby ordered and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Auditor of Twin Falls County, Idaho, immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.

Section 3 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
