

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHO LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 1945, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF APRIL, 1946, UPON ALL OF THE TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO, TO PROVIDE REVENUE TO PAY THE GENERAL CURRENT EXPENSES: MISCELLANEOUS EXPENSES: SIDEWALKS AND CROSSINGS LIGHTING THE STREETS OF SAID VILAGE; AND GENERAL STREET IMPROVEMENTS DURING SAID FISCAL YEAR; AND PROVIDING THAT THE VILLAGE CLERK SHALL FILE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR OF TWIN FALLS COUNTY, IDAHO, IMMEDIATELY AFTER ITS PASSAGE APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CASTLEFORD, IDAHO:

Section 1. There is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Castleford, Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of May, 1945, and ending on the close of business on the last day of April, 1946, an ad valorem taxes as follows;

A total of ten (10) mills upon every One Dollar (\$1.00) of the assessed valuation of all the taxable property within said village, to defray the costs of operation of said village for said fiscal year as follows;

1.9 mills for General and Miscellaneous Expenses of said village;

2.3 mills, costs of sidewalks and crossings of said village

3.1 mills for lighting the streets of said village ;

2.7 mills for General street Improvements.

Total ; 10. mills

Section 2. The village clerk of said village is hereby ordered and directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the county auditor of Twin Falls County, Idaho, immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
